Schuylkill Area Community Foundation is proud and pleased to share with you our 2018 Annual Report. As you will read in these pages, we distributed \$795,377.09 through designated distributions, grants, scholarships, and awards to organizations and students from in and around Schuylkill County. The generosity of our past, present, and future donors continues to make a positive impact on Schuylkill County each year.

In 2018, our philanthropic donors created seven new funds with our Foundation. As of December 31, 2018, we manage over 180 funds with a Market Value of \$24,017,816.

During 2018, SACF accepted the Fred G. Smith Golden Rule Trust from UNB Bank in Mount Carmel. You may read more about this fund and its positive impact on our Schuylkill County students on page six.

We continue to execute and develop scholarships and graduation awards for an increasing number of students in Schuylkill County. Planned gifts, estate planning, and fund agreements with the intent to fund upon death, allow SACF to execute the wishes of our donors exactly as intended after they have passed. # FUNDING CATEGORIES

Schuylkill Area Community Foundation continues to become an increasingly important source of funding to enhance the quality of life for Schuylkill County. The competitive grant process allows county nonprofit organizations to apply for a portion of SACF's available resources. The grants are awarded from the Friends of the Foundation Fund, Unrestricted Funds, and Field of Interest Funds.

#### ANIMAL WELFARE

Programs that foster the bond between animals and humans so as to improve the quality of life.

#### ARTS & CULTURE

Projects that encourage artistic creativity and enjoyment of the performing arts and cultural programming for the community.

#### DIVERSITY

Programs and activities in our schools and communities that will foster and enhance cultural appreciation, understanding and unity.

#### EDUCATION

Projects to enhance the educational experience for persons of any age that encourage literacy and promote lifelong learning skills.

#### ENVIRONMENT

Projects or activities relating to, but not limited to, conservation, agricultural programs, resource protection and energy/renewable resources.

#### HEALTH & WELLNESS

# NEW FUNDS

## Susan B. Berezwick Memorial Education Award Fund

Susie loved and supported her family and friends passionately. She enjoyed the storytelling of life and was a self-proclaimed medical specialist, often offering diagnosis and treatment options for those she loved the most. Sadly, Susie passed away in 2016 after a courageous battle with breast cancer.

In 2018, her family established an education award to honor and remember the passionate and loving matriarch, with an emphasis on how family shapes us as people. Each June, the "Fight For Susie" Golf Tournament is held to continue to raise funds for the award.

This fund provides an award to a graduating senior of Mahanoy Area High School who during his or her high school career has exhibited a commitment to education, sports and/or activities within school or in the community and plans to attend on a full time basis an institution of higher education.


## Schuylkill Technology Center Pass Through Fund (The Food Truck Fund)

The Schuylkill Technology Center launched a Food Truck Project in 2019, which involves converting a former bakery delivery truck into a fully functioning food truck that culinary students may utilize at community events.

The project is meant to involve students enrolled in as many of the STC Programs of Study at STC as possible. The students from plumbing and heating, welding, residential industrial electrical, precision machining and carpentry will work on installing the internal systems utilized to operate restaurant equipment. Collision repair and automotive technology students will work on vehicle components. Business students will develop marketing and fundraising plans, while criminal justice students research operating permits and licenses. Computer information system students will design and help install computer equipment.

Once operational, the food truck will be run by culinary students at local festivals and fairs as well as host on-site events for sponsors. The plan is to livestream the students preparing food on Facebook and other social media outlets.

This project is the first of its kind in the nation. The unique part is the school is using its own resources from start to finish. It doesn't end just making the truck, the goal after building it, is to operate it within the community and support other local businesses. Schuylkill Area Community Foundation accepts the tax deductible contributions to the Food Truck project.

## The Pediatric Autism Services Fund

The Pediatric Autism Services Fund was established in 2018 to provide financial assistance with out of pocket expenses for therapy sessions for children who have been diagnosed with Autism, and have been prescribed to receive Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) therapy plus Occupational (OT) or Speech Therapy at a center-based provider in, or with a satellite office in, Schuylkill County, PA.

Ashland Downtown Inc. was founded in 2004 to assist the borough of Ashland to preserve architectural charm, promote economic vitality and market its historic and cultural resources. The annual distributions of this Fund shall be used for the upkeep, maintenance, and beautification of the Hoffman Boulevard Islands and the Hoffman Memorial in Ashland, PA.

## Marian P. Brennan Scholarship Fund

Raised on a local dairy farm, Marian (Ludwig) Brennan began a 40 year career in 1935, teaching grades 1 through 8 at the one room Mabel School in Barry Township. She concluded her career in 1975 teaching grades 1 and 2 at the Barry Elementary School in the Tri-Valley School District. Her classroom goal was to ensure that students had the opportunity to maximize their potential. She focused on guiding and assisting students towards building a foundation for their individual educational development. This scholarship is intended to provide financial support for graduating students of the Tri-Valley School District as they pursue a college education.

# FRED SMITH GOLDEN RULE SCHOLARSHIP FUND

## Bloomsburg University and Trade School Scholarships

Upon his passing, Mr. Fred G. Smith, of Shenandoah and Mt. Carmel, established the Fred G. Smith Golden Rule Scholarship Fund in memory of his wife Marian M, and himself. Mr. Smith served in the Army during World War II, achieving the rank of private first class. He received the Croix de Guerre, which may either be awarded as an individual or unit award to those soldiers who distinguish themselves by acts of heroism involving combat with the enemy, during the liberation of Paris.

Mr. Smith wished to financially support students from Mt Carmel, Shenandoah, and Ashland who will attend, or are attending Bloomsburg University or a trade school. Mr. Smith prided himself in living by the Golden Rule "Do unto others what you would have others do unto you."

Schuylkill Area Community Foundation is honored to now administer this scholarship fund, which had previously been managed by our friends at UNB Bank of Mt. Carmel.

Mr. Smith also wished that recipients of the Fred G. Smith Golden Rule Scholarship would remember this prayer:

***"Stop and pray as you pass by,  
For as you are, so once was I,  
And as I am now, so shall you be,  
Prepare yourself to follow me."***

## Planned Giving Fund for the Future

Anna "Annie" Marie Wise was a fun-loving, caring, supportive, protective, and loving mother, wife, and daughter who helped people even when she didn't have much to give. Annie was constantly feeding all of the kids on her street, making and delivering Thanksgiving and other meals for neighbors and friends, and sending care packages to her son while he served overseas in the US Air Force.

She attended St. Mary's Catholic School in St. Clair, and lived and worked in the Pottsville and Schuylkill Haven areas for her entire life. Her Catholic faith was extremely important to her as demonstrated by her devotion to the Blessed Mother. Mrs. Wise's true enjoyment came from playing sports with her son, often being the defender, catcher, outfielder, and pitcher.

The Anna Marie Wise Memorial Scholarship Fund will be established through estate planning by her devoted son, David. David contacted his attorney, who then contacted Schuylkill Area Community Foundation, to work together to create a scholarship fund.

The Scholarship will provide two annual scholarships for trade school enrollment for students from Schuylkill County, who earn a minimum B+ throughout their high school career, have been committed to youth programs, and demonstrate financial need.





#### Investment & Spending Policies

The investment objective of your Community Foundation is to build funds that will meet the community's needs today and continue funding opportunities for generations to come. The Foundation's investment and spending policies are designed to preserve the inflation-adjusted spending power of its funds.

We utilize a "Total Return" approach to guide our investing and base our spending policy on a four-year average payout. This approach has enabled the Investment Committee and Board of Directors to fund the many grants and scholarships we have provided the community.
